Less CO₂: ArcelorMittal Eisenhüttenstadt and VNG work together in blast furnace conversion

Leipzig, 6 January 2021 – ArcelorMittal and the natural gas supplier VNG Handel & Vertrieb GmbH will cooperate with each other in future to make the production of steel products at the Eisenhüttenstadt site more sustainable. By 2030, ArcelorMittal, the world's largest steel and mining company in Europe, wants to make CO₂ savings of 30 per cent and carry out climate-neutral production by 2050. Within this framework, ArcelorMittal Eisenhüttenstadt initially plans to reduce CO₂ emissions in steel production by around five per cent per year from 2021 by converting the blast furnace. Natural gas will be used in the blast furnace in future to reduce the need for coal, which, in addition to reducing CO₂ emissions, will also contribute to lower energy costs. The conversion of the furnace is to be completed by mid-2021, and the costs of this investment amount to around four million euros.

As part of the Group's climate strategy, ArcelorMittal Eisenhüttenstadt – along with VNG Handel & Vertrieb GmbH – plans to add CO₂-neutral hydrogen in a later step, as soon as it is available in sufficient quantities and at an economic cost.
